Junior Farmers Counselor

The Children's Farm at The Center – Palos Park, IL
Seasonal Position, Residential or Daytime

Overview

Junior Farmers Counselors provide leadership, instruction, and supervision for children ages 3-8 participating in the Junior Farmers program during each of the six summer sessions. This role focuses on introducing campers to farm life, animal care, hands-on activities, and nature exploration, while ensuring a safe and engaging environment for all participants. Residential positions are required to attend all of pre-camp training, postcamp clean-up and staff meetings and will have overnight supervision duties of a residential bunkhouse including assisting with nighttime activities, overseeing bedtime routines and foster a strong cabin community with their residential campers. Daytime positions would only need to be available for portions of staff training.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead and facilitate the Junior Farmers program, including animal care, farm experiences, crafts, and nature exploration.
- Supervise all Junior Farmers campers and work with assigned Counselor-in-Trainings to provide a substantial, hands-on, fun learning experience for all participants
- Promote and maintain a safe and healthy environment for campers, staff, and visitors.
- Participate in pre-camp staff training and program preparation.
- Collaborate with other staff to support the broader mission and programs of The Center.

Qualifications

- Strong interest in working with children and supporting their personal growth.
- Commitment to fostering respect, sensitivity, and appreciation for others and the natural world.
- **Must be 17 years of age or older.**
- Preferred: enrollment in or completion of a degree in education, outdoor programming, human services, or related field.
- Enthusiasm, energy, patience, creativity, and emotional maturity.
- Good physical health to actively participate in outdoor and farm-based activities.
- Desire to assist with the camp program as part of the overall mission of The Center.
